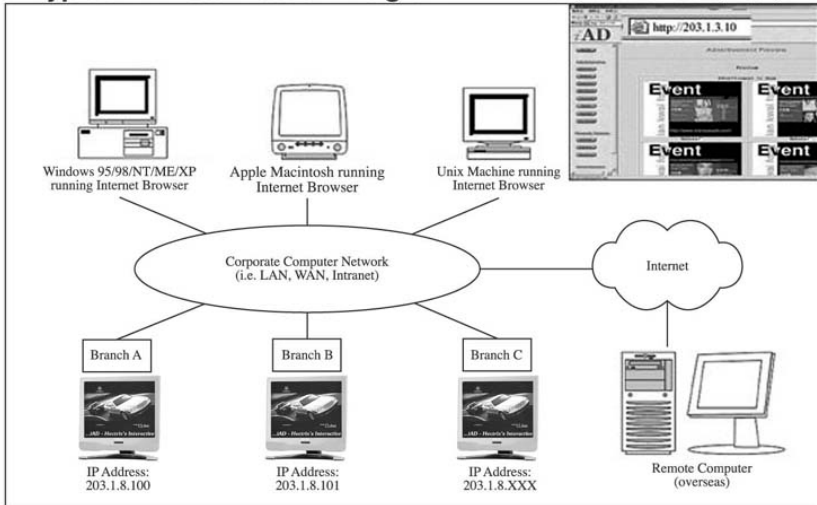


A Typical iAD Connection Diagram
